1. PROVISION / PROTECTION FOR THE JOURNEY

2. PROPHECY JUSTIFIED

Acts 28: 25 "So when they did not agree among themselves, they departed after Paul had said on word: 'The Holy Spirit spoke rightly through Isaiah the prophet to our fathers,..."
