- 2. What comes to mind when you think about being made in the image of God? Why is this a good starting point to talk about sexuality and gender?
- 3. Talk through each of the 9 realizations Pastor Andrew made on Sunday. Do you agree with them? Which ones are toughest to hear? Which ones have you never thought of before?
 - We were created by the Trinity.
 - God gave something of himself to us. We are people of transcendence.
 - It does not mean we are little gods.
 - It makes us unique, distinct and valuable.
 - It makes us a part of creation.
 - It means we were created for a purpose.
 - It means God's image is displayed in males and females. Gender matters.
 - It means we all share the same parents.
 - It reminds us something has gone wrong.
