

## Daniel Chapter 4: Pride, Madness and Restoration



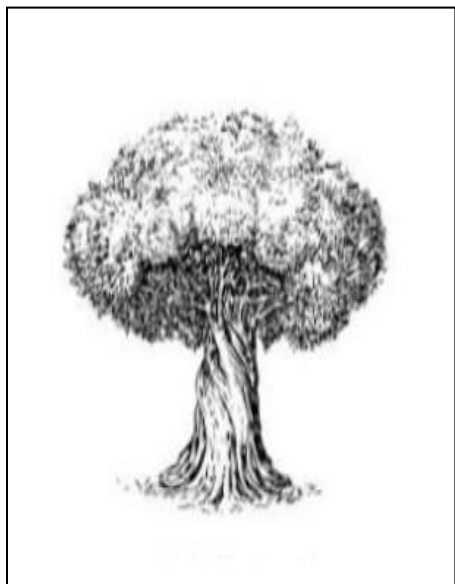

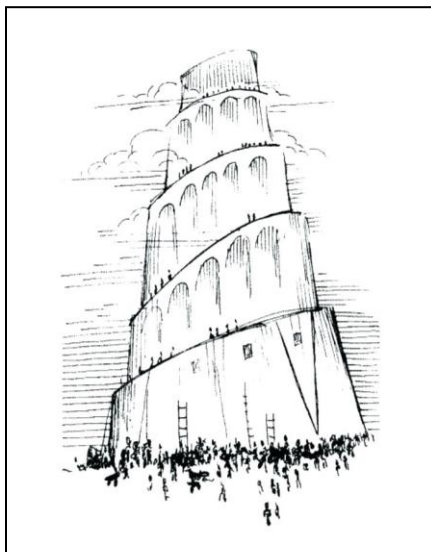
