### **3. B is for Bible.**

The primary way the Spirit moves and speaks into our lives is through the Scriptures.

4. *If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. Do not take revenge... but leave room for God's wrath (Ro. 12:18-19).*

5. *Make every effort to live in peace with all men and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord (Heb. 12:14).*

6. *Don't be selfish, don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves (Phil. 2:3, NLT).*

7. *For the Lord is good. His unfailing love continues forever, and his faithfulness continues to each generation (Ps. 100:5, NLT).*

8. *And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them (Ro. 8:28, NLT).*

9. *Do not withhold good from those who deserve it when it's in your power to help them (Pro. 3:27, NLT).*

### **10. C is for Church**

The most common way the Spirit speaks in the book of Acts (other than in and through the Scriptures) – is through the church, ie. Acts 13:2.

### **11. G is for Giftings**

*Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good (1 Cor. 12:7).*

### **12. S is for Sense of the Spirit.**

Throughout the bible – we see that God guides his people by placing burdens in their spirits, ie. Nehemiah (2:12), when Paul came to Athens (Acts 17:16).

**13. C is for Circumstances.**

Paul seems to see "open and closed doors" throughout his life as evidence of the Spirit's leadership, ie. 1 Cor. 16:8.
