- 2. Read 1 Timothy 2:1-8 together
- 3. When you read this passage what stands out to you?
- 4. Can you name a time that you offered prayers of supplication with a desperate need for God to intervene into a situation?
- 5. What are some of the barriers that you need to remove to find a time and location to be in communication with Jesus?
- 6. How do you personally offer your prayers of intercession to Jesus, whilst keeping your requests grounded from a pure heart, a good conscience and a sincere faith?
- 7. How does the Spirit speak to you?
- 8. Take time in your group to share one thing you have been asking Jesus for and have not seen or received and answer.
- 9. In your time of group prayer Take some time to pray for one another with passion and conviction.

Going Deeper: Take some time to write down the 5 names of friends or family who do not yet know Jesus and commit to praying for them every day for a month. If you can do it, I will buy you a Snickers!
