James 3:1-12

There must be a better way to control our tongues...

1. AN AUDIENCE MEANS MORE RESPONSIBILITY Proverbs 18:21

James debunks one of the great cultural myths of our time: That life is easier when you have a platform.

Just like a microphone amplifies your voice, leadership does not eliminate your character flaws, it enhances them.

2. DON'T LIE... NO SERIOUSLY, DON'T LIE

Our words have the power to direct our lives. They also have incredible destructive power. The most destructive words we can utter are lies.

Lies have unintended and disastrous consequences.

3. IF YOU CAN'T SAY NOTHIN' NICE, DON'T SAY NOTHIN' AT ALL
