// Step TWO: Scripture //

God is with you, and He has something life-giving to say. Let us open Psalm 27 and listen...

Read

Psalm 27:1

Discuss

- "God is my *light* and my *salvation*,"
What comes to mind when you hear this?

Read

Psalm 27:7-8

Discuss

- What does it mean to "seek God's face?"
- How can you seek God's face this week?



// Step THREE: Prayer //

God is here. He is speaking, and, He listens to us. Let's seek His face by praying. Pray by...

- ...thanking God for who He is (our Light, our Salvation, etc.)
- ...presenting our requests to God (pray for one another)
- ...supporting our health workers and political leaders

Benediction: close your time together with this good word...
