Vision

Mission Creek Alliance Church is has a simple focus. To Encounter Jesus, Empower People, and Engage our city and the world beyond.

We are looking for a summer intern to serve in our Children's Ministry. This position has been made possible because of a Canada Summer Job's Grant through the Government of Canada.

Responsibilities

The Children's Ministry Intern (CMI), under the supervision of the Children's Ministry Pastor (CMP), will provide programmatic support and leadership to the summer programs serving children and youth in the City of Kelowna through MCA Church. Your duties will include assisting in preparing and leading the programmatic elements of our various camps and programs. This will include: administration support, volunteer coordination, games, teaching, small group leading, public speaking, connecting with parents, and a variety of other duties tailored to the right candidate.

The specific projects you will be assisting or leading in are as follows:

- *Kids Day Camp* a week long camp serving the social and spiritual needs of children and their families in Kelowna.
- **Summer Soccer Camp** a week long camp aimed at building people, players and families through the sport of soccer.
- **Syrian Refugee English Program** This new program is designed to provide English training in an environment where moms can bring their children and learn together.

• **Summer Sunday School** – a weekly Sunday program where kids are led in songs, games and stories sharing related to Christian values.

Qualifications & Fit

We are looking for someone with administrative, leadership, and interpersonal skills who loves working with children.

Applicants must be:

- (a) between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive) at the start of employment;
- (b) registered as a full-time student during the preceding academic year;
- (c) intend to return to school on a full-time basis during the next academic year;
- (d) a student in a secondary, post-secondary, CEGEP (Quebec only), vocational or technical program;
- (e) a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and;
- (f) is legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial / territorial legislation and regulations
