

Gospel of Luke Study Questions Chap 1:1-56

- As we begin a sermon series on the gospel of Luke we will look at many stories regarding our Savior and his disciples. What are the assumptions regarding discipleship that you have before we look into the Scripture? What does being a disciple mean to you? What are some stories that come to mind in the gospels regarding discipleship?
- What qualities make a good disciple? What is required of a disciple? What does being a disciple of Christ look like in our world today? How has this changed from the days of Jesus?
- Zechariah was a righteous man and yet struggled to believe God would do something miraculous in his family's life. What is God teaching him in this story? What do we learn about God in this story? Why use silence as a punishment?
- The theme of bringing forth servants of God from women unable to have children is repeated in the Scripture. Why does God choose this method and what can we learn from it?
- Why would God have given Elizabeth a miraculous pregnancy, months before Mary? How does God use the bond of family as a support structure for Mary? How has God used your friends and family as a support structure for you? How is God calling or using you to be a support to others?
- What hardships will Mary face after her decision in verse 38? How big of a decision was that? In what areas of our lives is God calling us to give Him control and be His servant?
- Read verses 37 & 45. Discuss what these verse means to you and how you can live out this belief.
