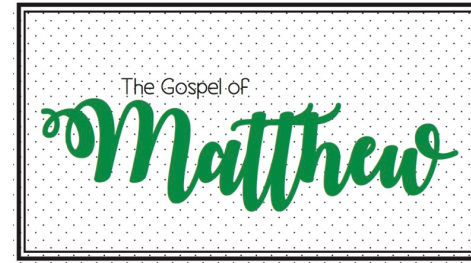




**Life Group Questions
