

**Read Acts 16:6-10, 17:1-15** What did God want from Paul? What struggles did they have? Why would God send them there?

**Read 1 Thess 1:4-2:2** What happened to the believers in that city after Paul left? How is this surprising? What are some ways you have passed judgement on something quickly as a success or failure but not given it enough time to unfold?

**Read 17:10-15** What attitude would Paul have after this? How have you gotten your hopes up before only to be let down later?

**Read 17:16-23** Do religious people today worship gods they don't know? How do we struggle with idolatry in our world?

**Read 17:24-31** What struggles would Greeks have believing in a living God? What made God so different?

Read 18:1-6 Why does Paul keep preaching to Jews first when he enters a new city? Why is he having so little success reaching people who knew the scriptures but great success with Greeks who knew very little? Why is Acts 18:9-10 such a pivotal point in this story? Would you have trouble believing God at this point? How does God keep His word a few verses later?
