

Gospel of Luke Study Questions
Luke 8:22-25

- Take a moment to reflect on the Easter Season and share with the group something that stood out to you and blessed you. What do you enjoy so much about Easter?
- Read Luke 8:22-25. What do we learn about the identity of Christ? What have we learned about His great authority so far in Luke? What do we learn in Jonah ch 1 about God's power over storms and his purpose for storms?
- Take some time and share together some of the major storms you have experienced in your life. Share how hopeless it felt or share how God miraculously carried you through it. This is a time to be honest and be willing to admit the moments where you had doubts in God.
- How often do we hear people outside of the church criticize God for letting bad things happen to good people? How can we use stories like this one in Luke and stories from our own lives to share the truth with non Christians? Why does God allow storms to happen? If someone is in the middle of a storm does that mean God does not care about them? If God does not remove our storms does that mean we are not good enough Christians? Discuss these questions and how you would answer them.
- Spend some time in prayer for each other and for our families and our church. Many people are going through storms and they feel alone or afraid. Some people might even be doubting God's faithfulness. Pray for them and discuss how you can find more ways to support the younger Christians in our church. In what ways can you encourage someone else going through a storm in life? Will you do it?
