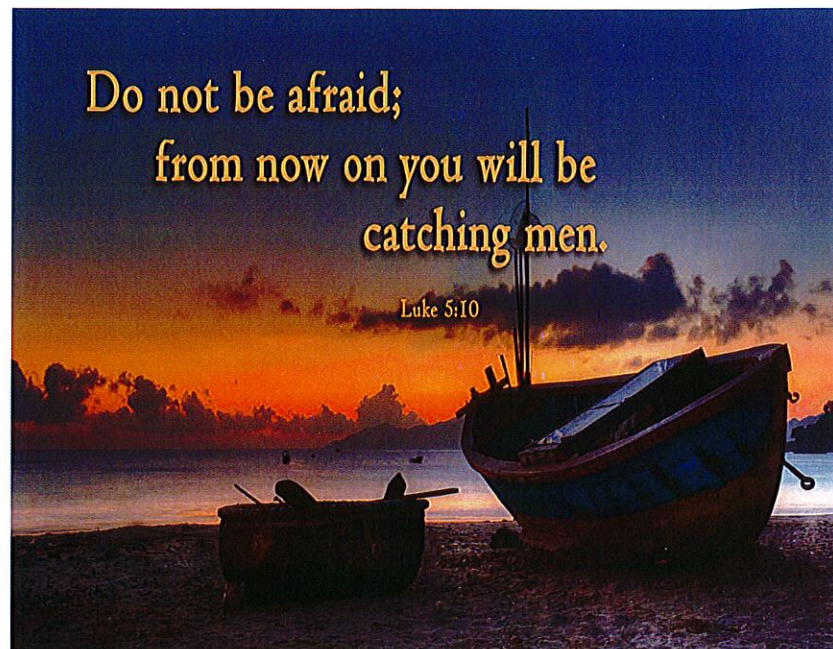

Gospel of Luke Study Questions  
Read Chap 5:1—39

- What was Simon's attitude when Jesus asked him to put out the nets again? Discuss what keeps you from trusting and obeying God? What was the result of putting out the fishing nets one more time? Will our results be the same when we trust and obey?
- What does fishing for men look like in our culture today? What would be the hardest part of leaving everything and following Jesus? What is God asking you to give up in order to follow him more closely?
- What do we learn about the power and character of Jesus from the healing of the Leper? How would this moment forever change the life of the Leper?
- Why would Jesus order the leper to remain quiet? How did the fame of Jesus' miracles begin to make ministry more difficult for him? Is the next story an example of this problem?
- What do we learn from the determination of the 4 men to get their friend healed by Jesus? Would we rip open roofs to save our friends and share the gospel with them? How might we need to use unconventional methods to save our friends?
- Why would Jesus forgive the paralyzed man's sin and not start by healing his legs? How would physically healing the man quiet the Pharisees who spoke against Jesus?
- Why would people criticize Jesus for choosing a tax collector as a disciple? How do we reach out to people who would not feel welcome in a church? What stands in their way of coming to know Jesus and how can we break down those barriers?
