- Sharing our skills and experiences to help support Rancho El Camino and the community it serves.

TYPICAL DAY ON THE RANCH

7am	Personal Time and time with God and Breakfast
9	Ranch Devo
9:45	Work projects including organic farming, building, caring for animals and daily chores
2	Lunch and Siesta
5-7.1	Visit families in the community, serve in computer / English classes
8pm	Dinner and family time

Day off will be sea kayaking and learning about environmental conservation in the Sea of Cortez.

Accommodation will be on the ranch or in a nearby guesthouse, depending on the ranch hospitality capacity during Spring Break.

COST

Cost: \$900 + air (adult), \$500 + air (child 10-19), \$300 + air (child under 10)

- **Cost includes:** Accommodation, food, transportation, entrance fees, all training and debriefing (manuals, books, food, activities).
- Optional 3-4 day add-on – estimated \$100 per day depending on quality of accommodation and food.
- Full trip costs are dependent on airfare prices at the time of purchase. Spring Break airfare to La Paz ranges from \$500 to \$1200 per person depending on booking time and routing. Flights through Mexico City are much less expensive than direct flights to Los Cabos. Flying out of Seattle is also less expensive.
- Full cost does not include: Passport, any vaccinations or medications that may be necessary, medical insurance, spending money.

LEVELS OF DIFFICULTY

Those interested in joining a Justice Journey must be FAST – Faithful, Available, Sweat (willing), Teachable

- LEVEL 1 – A great trip for beginners or those with little to no previous missions experience.
- LEVEL 2 – Cultural intelligence and experience are preferred but not required.
- LEVEL 3 – Previous cross-cultural / missions experience is preferred as these trips tend to deal with very difficult issues.

2019 SPRING BREAK JUSTICE JOURNEY TO MEXICO is level 1.
