Discussion Questions

1. What do you think of when you hear about evangelism or sharing our faith with others? How do you feel about doing that? Excited? Nervous? Do you feel like you are equipped to do that?
2. What was your initial reaction to the message from Michael Frost? How did it change or confirm the way you think about sharing your faith?
3. What do you think are some of the challenges or reasons why Christians do not share their faith effectively? What are some of things that make it intimidating for a lot of people?
4. Read Colossians 4:2-6. What does Paul ask the Colossians to pray for him? What does he encourage them to do in these verses?
5. What do you think it would look like for us to live out what Paul says in verses 5-6? Would that lead people in your life to be curious about why you live that way?
