We are getting closer and closer to that goal. We celebrated together

Before Vance left for this international conference in May, we started to think about the next step on our overseas missionary journey. We cannot believe that we have been in Saint Vincent & the Grenadines for two years now. In October, we plan to come back to Canada and the USA for three months to update as many of you as possible, and also have a brief rest. Missionaries call this time "Home Ministry Assignment" or "Furlough"

We are excited about the work God has done in this country and we see that He will do a greater work in the next two years. We applied for another two year visitor visa. The government of SVG has granted this request. This is an answer to our prayers.

Can we ask you to pray with us both now and during our furlough regarding our financial needs? It is common for support levels lower as a missionary is out on the field past their first year. This has been true for us also. We are currently at 81% of our needed monthly support. During this time, we will need to visit friends and individuals to raise our support level. CEF
