The times have changed but God hasn't

The world has changed over the last few months. Expressions rarely used before have become common place. When did you ever hear 'a cart apart' or 'social distancing' prior to this past March? Moving into the pandemic we were praying that God would provide \$2 million, as we needed that money to secure both the remaining \$2 million from the government for the housing portion of the building as well as to secure our loan for \$3 million in order to complete the project.

We are thankful to announce that during the pandemic the Lord provided just over \$2 million in pledges and gifts. He is a faithful God. We are thankful that we take possession of the building in mid-August and by mid-September will be able to provide housing for many who are in precarious living situations.

Simultaneously, we are disheartened to announce, that for a variety of reasons, we were informed in the middle of June that the building is now costing us an additional \$900,000. This brings the total cost of the building to nearly \$22 million.

What does this mean?

We are grateful that the Lord has provided just over \$9.7 million in pledges and gifts towards the project as well as \$6.3 million in guaranteed government funding toward

the housing portion of the project. In order to assist with the unprecedented rising costs in construction, as well as the costs incurred in the tariff wars, we were offered an addi-

tional \$2 million in government monies that was contingent upon our not having a mortgage of more than \$3.3 million (although we have only secured a mortgage of \$3 million). So we are praying that God will provide this \$900,000 in pledges and gifts by the end of September (the pledged monies need to be received by December 2020).

We are asking you to pray, give and introduce.
