

Slave Lake Alliance Church Re-opening Information Sheet

Risk Mitigation

- Physical Distancing Measures
 - Must be maintained between members of different households. Except for cohort* families.
 - Avoid sitting together unless from the same household or cohort* family

**Cohort is defined as small groups of people where members do not always keep 2 meters apart to a maximum of 15 people.*
- Hygiene and Respiratory Etiquette
 - Cough or sneeze into sleeve
 - Use provided hand sanitizer
 - Wear a non-medical mask if physical distancing cannot be maintained and expected to be in close contact with someone outside of your household or cohort family for longer than 15 minutes.
- Do Not Attend
 - If you are:
 - Feeling unwell
 - Experiencing most common symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat. New or worsening conditions)
 - Travelled outside of Canada (mandated quarantine for 14 days upon re-entry to Canada by Federal Government)
 - Had close contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case in the last 14 days (enforced by provincial Health Order)
- Parents, Families, and Caregivers
 - Keep young children close and not allow them to wander the sanctuary or other parts of the building
- Rapid Response Plan/Contact Tracing
 - We will be collecting names and contact information of attendees.
 - Providing information is voluntary for attendees,
 - Information is only required to be kept for 2 weeks and will only be asked to share with Alberta Health Services if a potential exposure occurs onsite. (This is strictly released for contact tracing purposes only.)

Facilities

- Expect control measures to limit support physical distancing among attendees
 - To avoid congestion around entrance/exit, please limit socializing in common areas

- Increased frequency of cleaning and disinfecting of high traffic areas, common areas, and washrooms
- High touch/shared surfaces such as doorknobs, light switches, bathroom fixtures, etc. frequently cleaned and disinfected
- Hand sanitizer at entrances and exits, and other areas throughout the building

Singing

- Congregational singing is discouraged. Feel free to hum along
- Worship band will continue to lead music, but with physical distancing measures enforced

Interpersonal Interactions

- Shaking hands, hugging, touching, or passing items between people must not occur, except between members of the same household or cohort family.

Shared Items

- To limit the sharing of items that cannot be cleaned and sanitized before and after each use (e.g. Bibles, notepads, pens, etc.) these are removed from the sanctuary and other common use areas. Please bring your own.
- Nursery/Toys
 - The nursery will not be available at this time. Baby room will remain available, but toys will be removed.
- Library – at this time please refrain from checking out books until proper protocols can be determined.
