

TEXT: 1 Corinthians 3:16-23

A stern REMINDER – WE, the church, are God's TEMPLE and therefore, PRECIOUS: 1 Corinthians 3:16-17

- 1) It IS POSSIBLE to DESTROY a local church through spiritual apathy, laziness, ungodliness, conflict, etc. (See Revelation 2-3)
- 2) It is NOT POSSIBLE to DESTROY THE CHURCH: Matthew 16:18

## A severe WARNING of DANGERS that may destroy the local Church:

- 1) **SELF-DECEPTION**: 1 Corinthians 3:18a
  - a) DON'T trust your NATURAL HEART/INCLINATIONS: Jer. 17:9
  - b) DON'T listen when your FLESH tells you that there is no God (or that you can act like He isn't there.): Psalm 14:1
  - c) DON'T DENY your own SINFULNESS: 1 John 1:8
  - d) **DON'T LIVE in HYPOCRISY**: James 1:26
  - e) DON'T VIEW earthly worldviews / arguments as MORALLY NEUTRAL: 2 Timothy 3:13
- 2) **PRIDE**: 1 Corinthians 3:18b. See also: Proverbs 3:5-6; Isaiah 5:21; Jeremiah 8:8-9; Romans 12:17
  - a) You DON'T have it ALL FIGURED OUT: Proverbs 3:7
  - b) You DON'T KNOW EVERYTHING you think you know: 1 Cor 8:2
  - c) You AREN'T the SOLUTION: Galatians 6:3
  - d) You AREN'T as STRONG as you think you are: 1 Cor. 10:12
  - e) You NEED JESUS (now): Matthew 11:25–26. See: James 1:5-8
- 3) HUMAN WISDOM (personalities, practices, priorities, systems, etc.): 1 Corinthians 3:19 Quoted from Job 5:13
  - a) God KNOWS our own wisdom is FUTILE (EMPTY): 1 Cor. 3:20. See also: Psalm 94:11
  - b) God is ACTIVELY OPPOSED to US living out of OUR OWN wisdom: 1 Corinthians 1:19. See also: Isaiah 29:14

- c) God has PROVIDED a BETTER WISDOM for US to live BY and FOR: 1 Corinthians 1:21–24
  - i) We don't need the Gospel + human wisdom
  - ii) We don't build our lives on human wisdom + the Gospel
  - iii) We don't remove truth from the Gospel when it contradicts human wisdom (Gospel human wisdom)
- 4) TRIBALISM (US vs THEM): 1 Corinthians 3:21a
  - a) DON'T find your IDENTITY, SELF-JUSTIFICATION, SATISFACTION in FACTIONS built around men: 1 Cor. 3:3–4 See also: 1:11-13
  - b) God MAY use SERVANTS but HE ALONE can give us NEW identities, absolution, and satisfaction (LIFE): 1 Cor. 3:5-6

## A strong ENCOURAGEMENT to build the CHURCH WELL, FAITHFULLY and ZEALOUSLY:

- 1) PLACE your FAITH in God's good, sufficient, generous, timely and gracious PROVISION: 1 Corinthians 3:21b
  - a) He has ALREADY GIVEN you ALL you NEED to live a GODLY LIFE: 2 Peter 1:3 See also: Romans 8:32
  - b) God will ALWAYS provide for ALL our NEEDS: Psalm 23:1. See also: Matthew 6:33; Philippians 4:19
  - c) He is NOT HOLDING OUT on giving you the BEST: Psalm 84:11b See also: Psalm 34:9-10; Matthew 7:11
  - d) God wants you to EXPERIENCE the ABUNDANCE of His PROVISION: 1 Corinthians 1:4-5, 7. See also: John 10:10
- 2) STEWARD ALL of God's good GIFTS: 1 Cor. 3:21–22. See also: 4:1-2
  - a) Spiritual LEADERS and DISCIPLERS: Ephesians 4:11–12
  - b) The CREATED WORLD (Relationships, Sex, Food, Wine, material Goods, Art, Music, Nature, etc): 1 Tim 4:4-5; 6:17. See also: Acts 14:17; 1 Tim 4:3
  - c) CIRCUMSTANCES (Places, People, Situations, Employment, Illness, etc.): Romans 8:28 See also: Gen. 50:20
  - d) TIMING, LIVING and DYING: Romans 14:7–9 See: Acts 20:24
- 3) **REMEMBER who you BELONG TO**: 1 Cor. 3:23 See also: John 17:10
  - a) The CHURCH belongs to JESUS (and therefore NOT to you or a group): Titus 2:13b–14. See: Eph. 5:23; Col 1:18; 1 Ptr 2:9-10
  - b) YOUR LIFE belongs to JESUS: 1 Corinthians 6:19–20; 2 Corinthians 5:15. See: vs. 7:23; Philippians 3:12; John 10:14-16
  - c) Therefore your life, like Christ's, is GIVEN OVER for the SAKE OF OTHERS and GOD'S GLORY: 1 Cor. 10:33 See: 1 Cor. 9:19-23

## Use these "Gospel In Life" questions this week to help you and your friends REFLECT on and APPLY this message!

- 1) **BELIEVE:** WHAT TRUTHS did God REVEAL to me through His Word today about HIM and/or MYSELF?
- 2) ASSESS: HOW do these truths ENCOURAGE and/or CHALLENGE (convict) ME?
- 3) PROCESS: WHY is this message GOOD NEWS (GOSPEL) to ME today? (CONNECT the GOSPEL story to MY present story)
- 4) **CHANGE:** WHERE will I APPLY (BELIEVE, REPENT, DO) this message in MY own life this week?
- 5) **PROCLAIM:** WHO does God want ME to share these truths with this week?
- 6) PREPARE for NEXT WEEK: Read 1 Corinthians 4:1-7
