## **SUMMARY FROM THE FEB 20 COUNCIL MEETING**

- 1. The Blanket Exercise was very successful, with about 60 in attendance, most non-Knox people.
- 2. The Nominating Committee will be asking for input to help fill several Council positions that will be open at year end.
- 3. Council voted against the UCC Remit Vote on a proposal to combine three orders of ministry (Ordained, Diaconal and Designated lay) into a single order. UCC will tally the votes from all Presbyteries and Congregations.
- 4. We have a decent balance in the refugee fund and our committee is considering how we will use it to support the local families.
- 5. Givings in January were the lowest since September, returning us to a deficit in our operating account.
- 6. Council decided to continue with the plan to dedicate the Easter Special Offering to deficit reduction. If we do end the year with a surplus, we would, as in other years, consider allocating a portion to an outside charity.
- 7. Phase 2 of the Wholeness Facilitation effort is now led by the Visioning Facilitation Team, with a focus on Values, Vision and Mission. Members are Jennifer Ferguson, Jo Dunn, Lois Grill, Kathy Grand, Nancy Newland, Lynne Pearson, Paul Vincent and Morganne Pickering
- 8. M&P has prepared a Police Records Check policy which would help us ensure we care for and protect everyone at Knox. Council will finalize the policy in May.
- 9. The office computer and desk have severe old age problems. It is likely that we will soon have to replace them.
- 10. Our application to the ProVision Fund of the United Church for \$2100 to fund the training of leaders for small group ministries has been approved.
- 11. Council approved the removal of 12 names from our membership roll.
- 12. The next meeting is March 20.


