Block things from a router level:

- **OpenDNS** – (FREE).
- **Clean Browser** – similar to OpenDNS, you can set Clean Browsing's clean DNS and block most known porn domains (FREE).

Smart TV Buying Guide- Questions you should be asking before you buy
