Adam, the Genome, & Evangelicals:

Airhart Theater, Ambrose University
Fri, Feb 3 rd 7:00 - 9:00 pm: Free public talk: Many Christians believe that humans are direct, supernatural creations who descend uniquely from a single ancestral couple. These convictions are under pressure from genomics evidence that humans evolved and descend from a large population, rather than from a single pair. How should Christians respond? Dr. Dennis R. Venema (Biologist) will explore the genomics evidence and consider its implications for evangelical faith and witness.
