Capital Improvement Overview and Estimates for Faith Lutheran Church Revised/updated 6/24/20 Joel Zimbelman, Council President

The following is an evolving list of needed capital improvements at Faith Lutheran Church. Section I list projects completed as of the date listed above. Section II lists projects which have been identified and, in some cases, ranked for their priority by the Church Council to be tackled in the future. Associated estimates are the most up-to-date available for the given item, and may be based on a guess, an informal estimate, or a written estimate by a given firm, as identified in the comments column on the spreadsheet. All costs are based on estimates of work done by bona fide professionals in Chico. However, as projects are implemented, opportunities for FLC members to provide in-kind labor and supplies might reduce actual costs (and, conversely, delays in project implementation could increase costs).

As discussed at the Annual Meeting, three rules will govern the work on these projects: 1) The Church Council will be responsible to rank capital projects based on their assessment of needs at FLC; 2) They will be responsible to get bids and estimates on all work, and will serve as the contracting agent for all such work on behalf of FLC; 3) Projects will commence only when funding or firm commitments for expenses have been secured from church members or other contributors.
