

#### Swift Current Votes March 1

Voters in the constituency of Swift Current will go to the polls on March 1. This provincial by-election will elect a new Member of the Legislative Assembly in Saskatchewan. To vote, you must be a Canadian citizen, at least 18 years old, have lived in Saskatchewan since August 2, 2017, and usually live in Swift Current. Most electors in Swift Current are already registered to vote, but if you need to update your information or register as a new voter, go to <a href="https://www.elections.sk.ca/voterregistration">www.elections.sk.ca/voterregistration</a> or call 1-877-958.8683. There are many ways to vote, such as at the polls on March 1 (the last day to vote), during advance voting (February 23 to 27), by mail or as a homebound voter. Whichever way you choose to vote, you will need to show ID, such as a driver's licence. Registered voters should watch for a voter information card to arrive in your mailbox before February 23.
