Discussion - Use these questions for personal reflection and family conversation/teaching after the sermon. Working through them will give you some things to focus on for the week, both for yourself and others. It is our prayer that they be of benefit for you as you come together in your homes to worship God.

- 1. How is my heart attitude toward submission during this time? Can I submit with joy even when it is inconvenient for me and my family? (Romans 13:1-2)
- 2. How can I support my leaders, at home, the church, or the government? Discuss ways you can actively do this. (social isolation, not fear-buying, etc)
- 3. How will I actively pursue community in this time of isolation? How can I encourage those around me (family, friends, neighbors, church members, etc)? We may need to be creative in how we interact and bless those around us! 1 Thess 5:11
- 4. How will I continue to give in order to be faithful? The financial needs of the church remain even though we are not gathering on Sunday mornings. One idea could be that every week, as part of your worship at home, you set aside your giving in an envelope to be given when we are back together. Alternatively, you can mail it in or even drop it off at the church during church hours. 1 Cor 16:2
