John 14:6-14

1. What insight, principle or observation from this week's message did you find to be most helpful, eye opening or troubling? Please explain.
2. At what moment in your life were you not sure you would have what it takes to get through? Was that moment tied to the question "God what are you doing?"
3. Read John 14:5-11. What did Jesus say about his relationship to God? How should this have been comforting to the disciples and to us today? According to verse 11, what did Jesus use to convince them?
4. As a group, list as many miracles as you can think of that Jesus did before his death and resurrection. Which, in your mind are the most miraculous or impressive?
5. Read verse 12. What impresses you, bewilders, or amazes you about what this verse says?
6. Alvin declared that the "greater things" actually refer to our work in bringing people to faith, what do you think about that? Jesus did the work of salvation, but left the work of making Christians up to us, how does that make you feel? What does that say about what our life purpose is and should be?
7. Read Verse 13-14. We can ask anything and Jesus will do it. What are the parameters that Jesus puts around "anything"?
8. If we have the power to join Jesus in building the future, by building the church, how can you join him in these "greater things" now? Who are you currently praying for on your pray for 4 list, and how are you investing in them?
