Matthew 3:13-17 (NLT) Then Jesus went from Galilee to the Jordan River to be baptized by John. 14 But John tried to talk him out of it. "I am the one who needs to be baptized by you," he said, "so why are you coming to me?" 15 But Jesus said, "It should be done, for we must carry out all that God requires." So John agreed to baptize him. 16 After his baptism, as Jesus came up out of the water, the heavens were opened and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and settling on him. 17 And a voice from heaven said, "This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy."

OBEY—we are baptized after believing in Jesus out of obedience

6) Acts 22:16 (NLT) "What are you waiting for? Get up and be baptized. Have your sins washed away by calling on the name of the Lord."

DISPLAY—baptism is a way to display your faith similar to the way a wedding ring displays that you are married.

7) Galatians 3:27 (NLT) And all who have been united with Christ in baptism have put on Christ, like putting on new clothes.

PORTRAY—baptism pictures what happens when we are saved

8) Romans 6:4 (NLT) For we died and were buried with Christ by baptism. And just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, now we also may live new lives.
