

Spring/Summer Sermon Series

Hallowed Be Thy Name

"Blessed be His glorious name forever! Let the whole earth be filled with His glory! Amen and amen!" Psalm 72:19

As we finish our study of Luke's Gospel here at Bridgeway Community Church, we recognize that many of the people who refused to follow Jesus did so because they did not know the LORD God. They had settled for knowing about Him rather than knowing Him, and so could not recognize Him when He came in the flesh (John 1:10-11).

Over the course of Spring and Summer 2018, we are going to examine some of the many names of God in our Scriptures. Almost every name of God is a self-description; it is God telling us who He is and what He is like. Through our study, we are going to draw closer to the God of Israel, the Creator of Heaven and Earth. This will deepen our trust in Him, our obedience to Him, and our proclamation of Him, so that we can echo the prayer of David – "Those who know Your name trust in You, for You, Oh LORD, have never abandoned anyone who searches for You" (Psalm 9:10).
