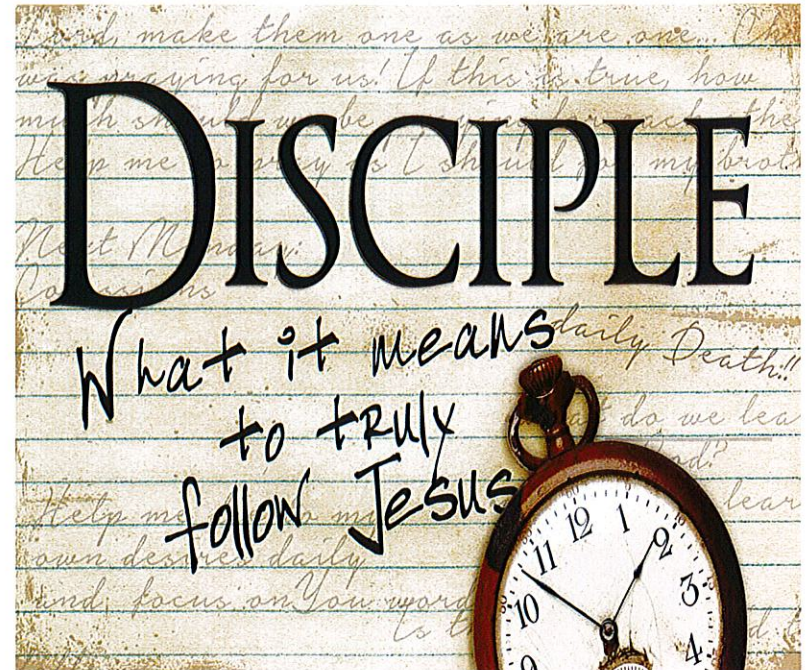

Gospel of Luke Study Questions
Luke 7:1-50

- When the Centurion sent elders to ask Jesus to come heal the servant they claim the Centurion deserved to have Jesus come preform a healing. How do we often approach God in prayer with an attitude of deserving something? What do your prayers normally look like? How have your prayers changed over the years? What should our attitude look like in prayer?
- Why did the Centurion not approach Jesus himself? Why would he not deserve Jesus under his roof? What do we learn about the heart of the Centurion through this? What application can we take from this story?
- When Jesus raises the boy from the dead He willingly comes into contact with the "bier" the board used to carry the dead body. Why would Jesus choose to make himself unclean by touching that? What do we learn about Jesus through this short story?
- Talk about the doubts that John the Baptist is having in Jesus now that John is in prison and how we would respond if we were in his shoes? What thoughts and emotions would he be wrestling with? Have you felt this same way towards God before? Have you experienced doubts when you were facing trials in your life? Share honestly with your group.
- How is the heart of the Pharisee different from the heart of the sinful woman? What can we learn from this story about our own hearts and attitudes?
- What steps of obedience do you feel God is calling you to in your life? How can you take one step closer to this goal this week?

Our church is creating a stronger focus on the ministry of prayer. What is one request you can post on the wall of the prayer room this week at church? Will you have the courage to post it on the wall? Will you take a moment and pray for another request on the wall.
