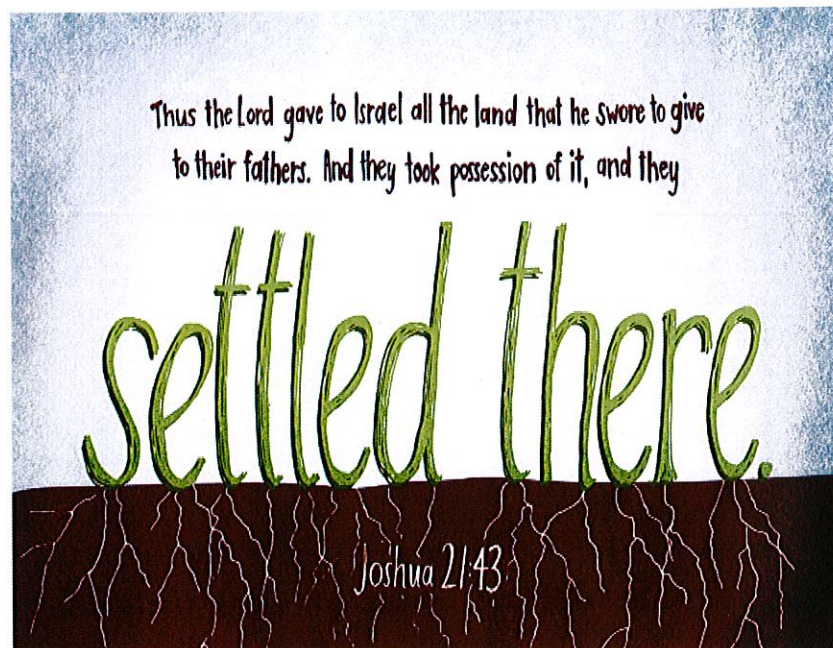

I have some great news to share with all of you! Our family is adjusting well to life here in Canada and there are a few things I want to share with you and some things to pray for!

Even though the government has only given emergency coverage for dental work for the family under the refugee program, the family doctor has been able to prescribe them that needed dental care. The dental clinic staff have been very generous and supportive as well! Praise God for this provision! Please keep praying for the family in this area and the improved health of everyone.

School is starting in 2 1/2 weeks! The summer has flown by and the children are excited AND nervous to start school. A HUGE thank you to the Lutheran church committee for being willing to organize supplies and to All Saints Elementary School for raising money for this specifically. Please pray for the children and parents as they approach another BIG change in their routine.

Parents are starting English lessons. Pray for determination, comprehension and retention as they face this challenge!
