1 Samuel 24

1. What insight, principle or observation from this week's message did you find to be most helpful, eye opening or troubling? Please explain.
2. Have you ever been in a rush and then someone or something got in your way? (grocery line, driving...)
3. Have you ever felt like you were gifted, deserved, or were born for something, and then it didn't happen as quickly as you wished? Or you had a vision or a dream for something and it didn't happen as quickly as you liked? How did you respond? How were you tempted to respond?
4. Read 1 Samuel 24. Why do you think David refrained from taking out Saul? Would he have been justified in taking Saul's life? Why or why not?
5. Alvin mentioned that pride and selfish ambition in David had to die and it was almost the death of him. How was this true of David? How might this be true of us as well?
6. Few of us like or choose the slow difficult pathway of brokenness. Why was it important for David? Why might it be important for us to experience brokenness?
7. What would it look like for you right now to trust God, and allow him to teach you by being patient and willing, not running ahead? How are you tempted to be a Saul right now and protect your space? How are you tempted to be an Absalom right now, and run ahead and take what you can? In what ways are you being asked to be a David, to wait, and not crush those around?
