J&F serve with MB Mission in a restricted region. Pray for this couple as they seek to minister among the least reached in East Asia.

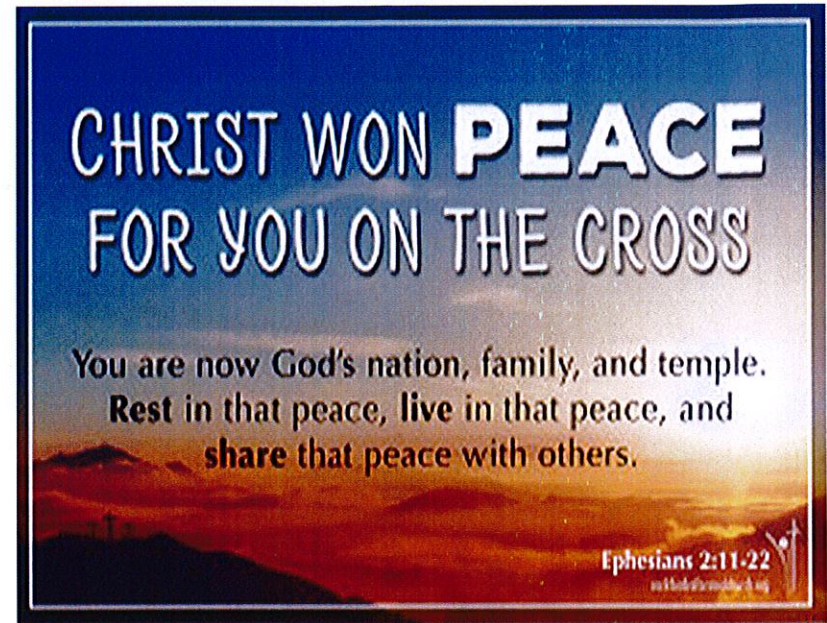

How do we alienate people who are different from us from joining the church?

What barriers still exist in our churches today between individual Christians and between different churches? Why do these barriers still exist if Christ died to bring peace between believers?

How can we break down these dividing walls?  
What privileges come with citizenship in our country that we take for granted?

What privileges do we receive with citizenship in God's household? Does this change your perspective on the privilege of having salvation?

If believers are a building being constructed for the Holy Spirit to dwell in, like verse 22 says, in what areas does our church still need to finish construction?

What areas in your own life are still under construction?
