### VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT TO HELP SYRIAN REFUGEES - The Syrian conflict



has entered its sixth year and, according to World Vision, at least 250,000 people have been killed, among them up to 19,000 children, and approximately 11 million people have been forced from their homes. We, the grade five class at Covenant Christian School, are not okay with this and have decided to raise funds in order to help refugees. We want to □ live God's story by being Justice-Seekers, Community-Builders, Servant-Workers, and Image-Reflectors. As a result, we have chosen to hold a volleyball tournament again this year! It will

be held at Covenant Christian School on Saturday, February 4, 2017 starting at 9:00. The cost of entering a team of 6-8 people is \$80 (you are allowed to contribute more than \$80, if you'd like). There will be a concession available in order for you to keep your energy levels up. We encourage you to make use of it as all of the profits from the concession will be going to help refugees as well. 
