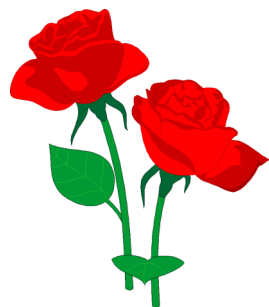


If you should meet her first,
