Scripture: Galatians 3:10-14

## SERMON QUESTIONS:

1. What did the Spirit teach you through the sermon?
2. How does having righteousness credited to us change the way we see ourselves, our Christian lives, and Jesus himself?
3. Has this passage given you more or less confidence in the fact that your sins have actually been paid for by Christ? Explain.
4. So what did Paul mean when he said "Christ redeemed us"? Look up the following verses to help you unpack the theological significance of the term (Titus 2:14; Romans 3:24; Ephesians 1:7).
5. In Galatians 3:13 it says that Christ "became a curse for us." What do we learn about Christ as our curse-bearer from that verse and the following: 2Corinthians 5:21; 1Peter 2:21-24; Isaiah 53:4-6?
6. In Galatians 3:8 and now in 3:14 God seems to care deeply about justifying the Nations/ Gentiles. How often do you think about how God wants to use you to accomplish this plan? How are you making yourself available and how are you intentionally positioning yourself to be used by God in this way?
7. Think of one person you know who could benefit right now from hearing this good news. Take some time to pray over this person and decide how you can share the Gospel with them. If someone doesn't come to mind, why not? If this task seems "too radical," share your feelings or thoughts.

**ACCOUNTABILITY QUESTIONS:**

1. Describe a struggle in your Christian walk this week.
2. Have you given into temptation since we met last? Is there anything the Lord is leading you to confess?
3. How has your time of Bible study and prayer been?
4. Who has God put in your life that you need to share the gospel with?

2. Who are you praying for? (Who has God put in your life that you need to share the gospel and life with?)
