1. Can you think of a time when you most felt the love of God through His people? What was the circumstance? What was the result in your life?
2. Where have you seen the gospel transform a heart you would have never expected? What does this tell you about God's power and His heart?

DIG DEEPER

Read Philippians 4:21-23

3. How can you see the value of Christian community emphasized in these verses?
4. What is the significance that Paul desired to greet "every" saint in Christ Jesus (vs. 21)?
Apply: What does *how we greet (or fail to greet)* each other in our assemblies reveal about us?
5. What is the significance of verse 22? Why is this exciting?
6. What does a true belief in the power of the gospel do to our proclamation of the gospel?
7. Read Philippians 1:2 & 4:23. What word 'book-ends' this epistle? Why is that so important?

BRING IT HOME

8. Looking back at our study in the book of Philippians, what verses, thoughts or ideas had the greatest impact on you? How do you want this truth to change your life? Share at least one of these with someone in your home or elsewhere!
