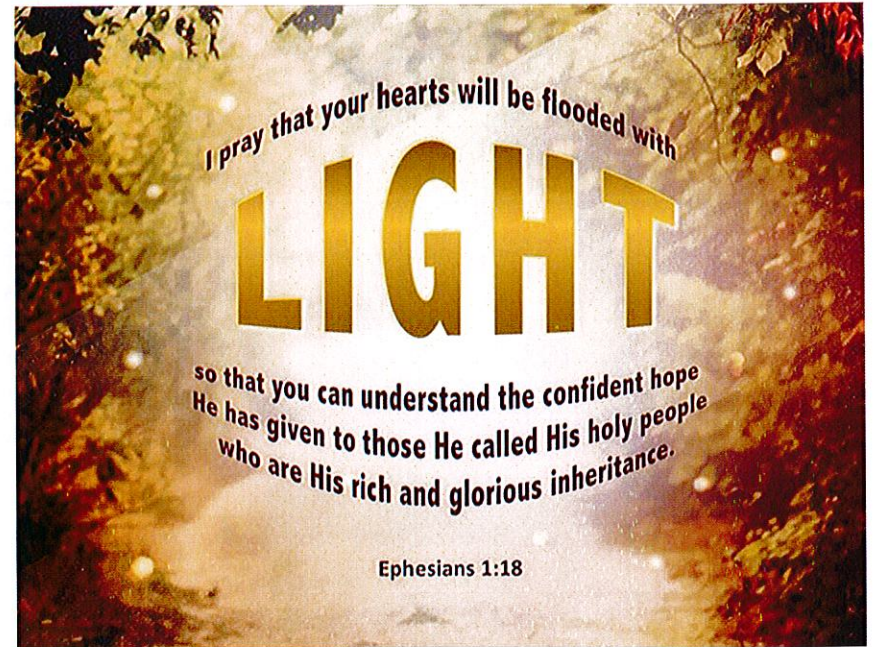

## Ephesians Study Questions Ch 1:15-23

What did you take home from Sunday's sermon? (A truth, thought, application point or maybe a big question that you wish had been answered?)

Someone read Ephesians 1:1-14. This gives us context. Now someone read Ephesians 1:15-23 for today's questions.

Open your discussion today with multiple prayers of thanks for the faithful loving saints in your life and your church.

God gives us the Spirit to allow us to gain wisdom and know him more intimately. In what ways has the Spirit assisted you to know God better? What impact has that had on your life?

Read Verses 18-19 Why are all three of these areas (hope, riches and power) important to understand personally and for our church to understand as a body? How will a follower of Christ struggle if they only know one of these areas?

When sharing the gospel with people who do not believe in Christ how we can use hope, riches and power to explain salvation and our obedience?

Verses 20-23 refer to Christ's power and His current position in Heaven. What stands out to you from this passage and encourages you? How does this passage give us hope, riches and power?

Go around your group and pray for non-believers in your life who need to know God's hope, riches and power.
