2 Corinthians 5:19

The First Lesson: **Exodus 12:1-14** The ancient feast of Passover is described – which is central to the faith of our Jewish sisters and brothers. At its heart is the understanding is that God has delivered his people. We therefore live in this promise of God's reign and freedom.

Epistle: **Romans 13:8-14** One can see that, even in ancient times, there was a governing authority over society. Paul, therefore encouraged the people, who were living in that time, to so with the Spirit of love.

The Gospel: **St. Matthew 18:15-20** From our reading of the Gospels, it is evident that conflict existed even in the ancient community to which Jesus lived. Jesus call to his followers was always based on forgiveness – one which was to be carried out through acts of love. It reminds us that love is not only a choice, but when love is carried out, even in difficult times, that Jesus is present.
