





WILLIAMS LAKE UPDATE - Thank you for all the encouragement and prayers for Williams Lake. On July 27, the evacuation order was lifted for the city and some surrounding areas. While an evacuation alert remains in place, people are trickling back home. With the fires not under control, there is still anxiety and uncertainty. It's difficult to give an accurate read on the impact of these fires, but significant loss to the lumber industry, cattle, homes and jobs is a given. THE HEAVENS DECLARE THE GLORY OF GOD - This coming up weekend is the Perseid Meteor Shower. The peak will be on Saturday, August 12, but it will also be visible on Friday and Sunday nights. And on Monday, August 21 there will be a rare total solar eclipse visible in the northern USA, with a partial solar eclipse in Canada. In Edmonton the eclipse will be 75%; it will start at 10:24 am and end at 12:49 pm, with the maximum at 11:35 am.
