SERMON GUIDE

“UNITED WITH CHRIST”
ROMANS 6:1-14

- ➔ Pray for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes and guide you in all truth (John 16:13-16) as you reflect on his Word.
- ➔ Read Romans 6:1-14 aloud
- ➔ In what ways have you taken God’s grace for granted? How have you chosen to walk in disobedience knowing that God has forgiven you?
- ➔ What does it mean to have union with Christ? We know that we have forgiveness of sin (past) and we also know we will be with Christ in glory in the future. How does being united with Christ affect how who we are and how we live in the present?
- ➔ What parts of your old self are you holding on to that prevent you from living to God?
- ➔ How difficult has it been for you to live in the freedom of Christ? Does sin have a hold on you that cannot seem to find freedom from? Do you struggle with unbelief in the reality of the freedom Jesus has secured for you in his death and resurrection?
- ➔ What is God saying to you in this Word, in the sermon, and in your walk with Him this week?
- ➔ What is God telling you to do? How can we be part of helping you obey?
- ➔ If you are discussing these questions as a Group, pray for one another in the specific ways the Holy Spirit is speaking truth into your lives.
