

- 1. One who is learning to love like Jesus
  - a. A ministry leader must be someone whose life is committed to the way of Jesus in a way that it shows through their love.
  - b. A ministry leader must be someone who is actively engaged in practices and relationships that help them keep their eyes on Jesus and continue to grow "in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ."
- 2. One who reflects the humility of Jesus (Read Philippians 2:1-11)
  - a. We don't expect anyone to have arrived at this, but there should be evidence of growing in humility like Jesus.
  - b. One whose first posture as a leader is one of service who is excited to build up others, let others get the credit, and is willing to be accountable.
- 3. One who is rooted in the assurance of God's love
  - a. Again . . . this is something we grow in, but our desire is that leaders be men and women who serve out of the overflow of what they are receiving from God and not trying to "do it" in their own strength.
  - b. One who is not trying to receive validation or worth through their work, success, or opinion being affirmed. Rather, because they are secure in Jesus, they hold all things with open hands ready to contribute in whatever manner is good for the kingdom of God.
  - c. One who will, because they are secure in God's love, have the courage to speak up in love even when concerned that their voice may be unpopular or unheeded and have the courage to act even when what is needed will be difficult. (Willing to pursue BHAGS Big Hair Audacious Goals for the kingdom of God.)
  - d. One who is willing to fail without self-condemnation and one who is willing to allow others to fail without condemnation.
