

The Act of Covenanting

Andy: In Jesus the Christ, God came into the world not to be served, but to serve. By our baptism we are called to a ministry of worship, witness and reconciliation. As we prepare to make commitments to one another now, let us first stand and join in a statement of our communal faith.

We are called to be the Church: to celebrate God's presence, to live with respect in Creation, to love and serve others. to seek justice and resist evil, to proclaim Jesus, crucified and risen. our judge and our hope.
