## GLEANINGS FROM THE CUC COUNCIL TABLE (September 25, 2018)



- Council discussed and unanimously approved, the recommended action to affix appropriate coverings over the exterior surface of the stained glass window above the church entrance, to preserve and protect it.
- ♣ The church received a request from local MP John Aldag, to join him at Precious Blood Parish on October 10, along with a contingent of other local Faith Community Leaders, to strategize actions to address local concerns related to gaps in community support services.
- Council is prayerfully going forward with discussions to resolve our need under church policy, for additional M&P representation to support our Ministry Team in addition to the Pastoral Charge.
- As our Affirmed Committee Chair and Council Representative, Casey Nieuwenhuizen will participate in an important Diversity/Inclusion Workshop, scheduled on October 13 at Crossroads United Church. We are asking members of our church family to support her and our journey to becoming an Affirming Church by attending with her.
