What was the first emotional reaction of the women? Note Mark 16:6.

Put yourself in the place of these women. What would you have thought and felt?

Why does the resurrection of Jesus change everything for us as followers of Jesus?

What is the message of 1 Corinthians 15:14 and 1 Corinthians 15:17?

What is a Christian atheist? Why do these people count on a dead Jesus?

What hope is brought to us in Jesus? What does John 10:10 tell us?

How do you walk this day? Is Jesus alive or dead in your life?
