# Today's Scripture

**Isaiah 58**: the prophet challenges the shallowness of religious observance by the exiled Jews. They are soon to return to their homeland. He calls for compassion  $\mathring{c}$  social justice.

**I Corinthians 2**: Paul urges the Corinthian Christians to discern the hidden wisdom of God, guided by the Spirit of God.

**Matthew 5**: Jesus uses striking metaphors of mission, namely salt  $\dot{\mathcal{C}}$  light. The observance of the Jewish Law was an issue much discussed by Jewish  $\dot{\mathcal{C}}$  Gentile Christians.
