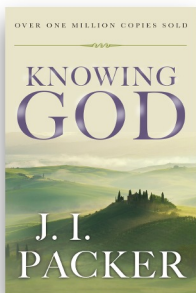

Nehemiah 7:73b–13:31

Principle: Believers respond to God's Word by turning away from sin and humbly depending on Christ.
