What gives me hope is the knowledge that God is with us. As the poet said, "You are a hiding place for me; you preserve me from trouble; you surround me with glad cries of deliverance" (Psalm 32:7).

The Food Pantry has moved to Duff Street UM Church Multiministries Bldg on the FIRST FLOOR which will make it more convenient for our families and our volunteers.

Thank you to the Stealey UM Church for housing the Food Pantry for the last three years and we are pleased that our two churches will continue our food ministry together to serve our neighborhood and community.

Due to the COVID-19 virus, extra precautions and social distancing will be observed. The Food Pantry is considered an Essential Service. We will give out prebagged food and are not able to offer a selection during this time. We do not have all our usual items but have food that will help feed your family.

If you have been to the Food Pantry before, all we will need is your name as we have your essential information. We will bring the food to the door and you will not need to enter the building.

New families will need an ID, proof of residency if not on ID. Birthdates of all family members.

We have received food from the Mountaineer Food Bank, but if when shopping you are allowed 2 loaves of bread or 2 dozen eggs and you only need one, consider buying extra for the Food Pantry. Can also use Spaghettios and Spaghetti Sauce. Money donations also help us purchase needed items.



**Backpack Program** –The Backpack Program is on hold until students return to school. A date for bag assembly will be determined as soon as they return.




