BREAKING THE ICE:

- In what way would being physically blind change your life?
- What are some common “blind spots” that you see in others (remember to protect the identity of the person)?

Read Mark 10:46-52

Why do you think they recorded this man's name? It was not often that a healed person's name was recorded in the Gospels.

Discuss the Lessons from a blind beggar and how they can help us see Jesus in our everyday life.

- 1) Don't wait for perfect conditions
- 2) Concentrate on what you have
- 3) Don't be swayed by public opinion
 - faith suckers
 - faith intimidators
 - faith mockers
- 4) Jesus hears the cries of desperate people
- 5) Follow Jesus when times turn good

1. What do you need to throw aside so that you can see Jesus?
2. In the areas where you need clarity, ask someone who knows Jesus well to help you recognize your blind spots.
