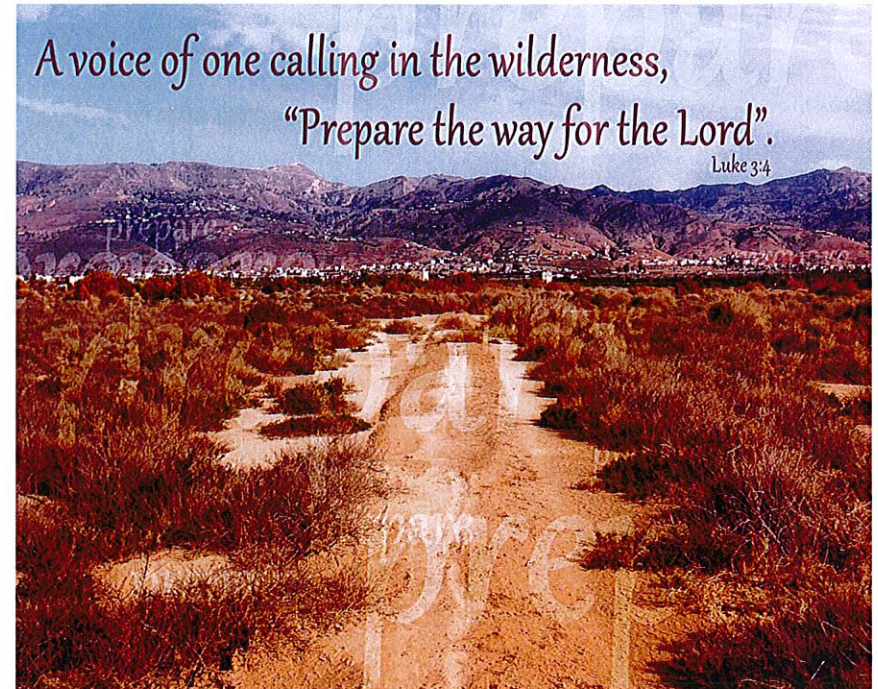

Gospel of Luke Study Questions
Read Chap 3:1-22

- How would a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins conflict with the way people understood forgiveness under the sacrificial system? What would repentance mean to them? What do you think it means to repent of sin?
- We often hear that John the Baptist prepared the way for Jesus but how did he do that? How was the Jewish nation more prepared because of John's work? How do we play a role in preparing others to understand salvation today?
- How did John have to battle people who felt entitled to salvation? Why did he call them Vipers? How do we in the church today handle entitlement? How should we talk to someone who is living in sin but feels entitled to live how they choose? How do we handle confrontation from other Christians?
- How were the hearts of people being opened up as they came to be baptized? Why would John emphasize sharing food and clothing, and being honest with your money as a part of living out salvation? How do you practice this in your own family? What are some challenges to living selflessly?
- How should we understand the difference between John's baptism of water and Jesus's baptism of the Holy Spirit? What baptism do we practice today in our church? How would repentance and baptism change once the Holy Spirit was involved? Share your baptism story with the group.
- Why would Jesus choose to be baptized? Why should we get baptized? Why would God speak from Heaven during the baptism? Does this story help us understand the 3 parts of the Trinity being able to see them all at work in a single moment? How do you understand the Trinity?
