ARTICLE III - STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe that there is one true and living God. He lives in three persons – the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. (John 1:1; 1 Peter 1:2; John 6:27; John 3: 5-6, 8; Matthew 28:19; Matthew 3: 16-17; Hebrews 1:3)

John 20:31 (John's purpose in writing):

A "living" God...

We believe that God has created man in His own image. Man was endowed with the freedom of choice. He chose to disobey God, thus, marring the image of God and bringing sin into the world. (Genesis 1:26-27; Genesis 2:7; Romans 3:23; Genesis 3:22-23)

Every life is valuable and created with purpose! (*Have you found yours?)

We believe that sin destroys the relationship between God and man. This brings about eternal condemnation and separation from God of the unsaved in hell to those whose sins are unforgiven. (Ephesians 2:3; Romans 5:12; 1 John 1:9; Revelations 20:15)

We are "weighed down" by the curse of sin. (*Do you feel it?)

Judged by the books (your life) or by the book (of life)?

Revelation 3:5 (Jesus will defend his own at judgment)

We believe in the incarnation and virgin birth of Jesus Christ, and that He is truly God and truly man. He died on the cross for our sins. He rose bodily from the dead, ascended into heaven where He sits at the right hand of the Father as our High Priest and Advocate, and is coming again. (John 1:14; Isaiah 7:14; Isaiah 9:6; Luke 1:34; Matthew 27:31; Mark 15:25; 1 Corinthians 15: 3-8; Hebrews 4:14-16; Zechariah 14; Revelations 19:11-16)
